

Oral Surgery MCN's

Following the publication of the Guide to Commissioning Oral Surgery and Oral Medicine by NHS England, MCN's are developing into an important group that provide Local Dental Networks and Commissioners with local professional advice about the Commissioning of Oral Surgery Services. This includes development and introduction of Electronic Referral Management Systems and development of a quality control framework that ensures patients receive the best possible quality of Oral Surgery care across all treatment complexity levels and across all providers.

Most recently the National Implementation Group working on development of MCN's has published the generic Terms of Reference for MCN's and also the Job Description and Person Specification for the Chair of an MCN. These are included on this site.

As your Specialist Association we recommend that you get involved in your local Oral Surgery MCN. If there is not one set up in your location then we suggest you approach the Chair of your local LDN and offer to set up an MCN. This site includes a spreadsheet with the current set up of MCN's across England to our best knowledge. If you work in an area that has a functioning Oral Surgery MCN that is not on this list then please let BAOS know so that we can update this information.
